A	Complete: complete paralysis of both perception and movement in S4-S5
B	Incomplete: only perceptual functions remain below the neurological level, including S4 to S5
C	Incomplete: motor function remains below the neurological level, but more than half of the major muscle groups have less than 3 muscle strength
D	Incomplete: motor function remains below the neurological level, and at least half of the major muscle groups have muscle strength 3 or greater
E	Normal: Normal motion perception

A	Complete	Complete paralysis of motor perception below the injury height
B	Sensory only	Complete paralysis of movement, with some preservation of perception only.
C	Motor useless	There's a little bit of muscle strength below the injury height, but it's not practical.
D	Motor useful	Practicality of muscle strength below the injury height and able to walk with or without the need for assistive devices
E	Recovery	No muscle weakness, no sensory deficits, no sphincter damage, and abnormal reflexes may be present.

I have entered this Award with the following understanding and acceptance.

(a) Violent and demanding behavior.

(b) Unreasonable demands in excess of their legal responsibilities.

(c) Threatening words or actions or using violence.

(d) Any action that damages the Award or the reputation of the Award or the Organizer, or interferes with the work of the Competition, by spreading rumors or using deception or force.

- Non-infringement of intellectual property rights and compliance with laws and regulations

I, and the organization to which I belong, pledge that the robot used in this Award will not infringe on the intellectual property or other rights of any third party and will not violate all applicable laws and regulations.
